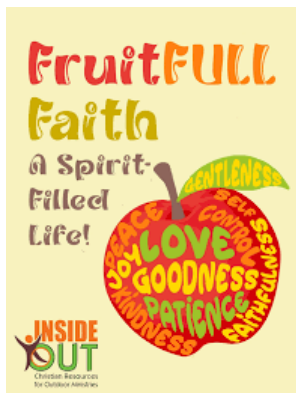


SUMMER CAMP!
